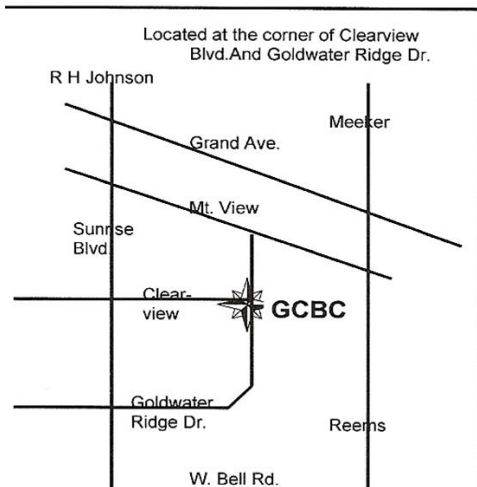

From Your Pastor

We all need to maintain the skill of noticing whatever needs to be changed and then following through on the change. When we stop actively supervising our own habits and patterns, we unintentionally start giving control of our life over to culture, circumstances and our enemies, especially the devil. Nobody wants this to happen, and since I am the preacher, I am allowed to be invasive, so allow me to make a number of suggestions on areas to change and recommend specific actions for each./
